Things you should know

Utility bill

- Bills include water, sewer, and trash services.
 Bills are sent on the first business day of the month.
- Bills are due on the 16th of each month.
- If accounts are not paid in full at 8 am on the first business day following the 21st of each month, accounts are charged a 10% late fee.
- For accounts with a balance more than \$100: If payment is not received by 8 am on the 20th of the following month, water service will be disconnected and a \$50 reconnection fee will be added to the account. To have the water service reconnected, residents need to pay the full balance on their account including the \$50 reconnection fee.
- We set reminder calls to all accounts subject to disconnection of water service. Make sure we have your updated contact information.

Trash & Recycling

- Trash & recycling services are provided by GFL Environmental.
- Trash and Recycling Pick-Up Routes can be found on the website under Residents > Trash & Recycling

A **Senior Discount** on water and wastewater fixed rates and trash/ recycling is available for account holders over 65 years old. To apply visit the City's website or call City Hall.

Permits

All construction in or to a structure such as the house or garage will likely require a permit. Additionally, the City requires permits for fences, decks, pools and outbuildings larger than 120 square feet. It is recommended that all persons interested in constructing in the city limits to contact the Building Regulations Department to find out what permits are needed and the cost for the permit.

Business license

The municipal code of Smithville requires all businesses procure a license before doing business in the City. State statute requires the City to ensure Sales Tax has been paid to the State of Missouri.

Code Enforcement

The most common code enforcement violations:

- Tall Grass and Weeds
- Trash, Rubbish and Debris
- Inoperable and Unlicensed vehicles
- Protective Treatment on wood surfaces.
- Premise Identification
- Fences in poor condition
- Unapproved parking
- Grass clippings and tree leaves deposited
 onto public streets and sidewalks.

Dogs over the age of six months need to be registered with the City.
